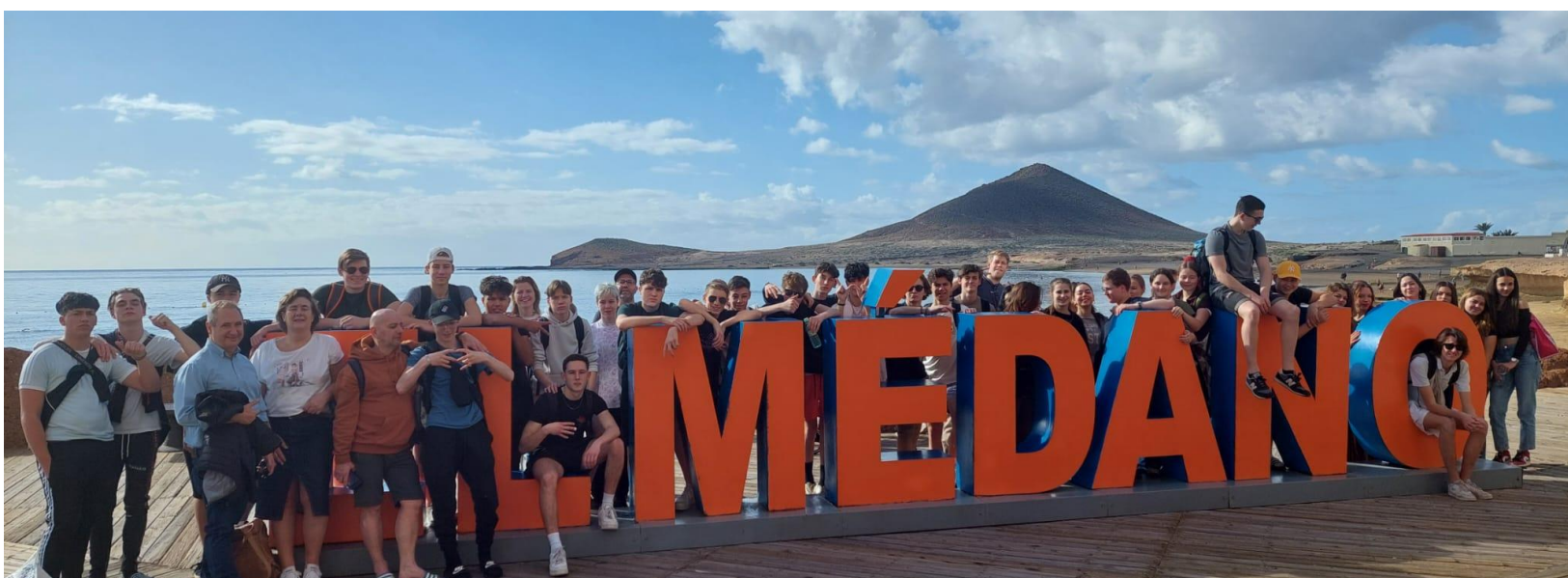

Connecting activities

Isendoorn Competencies

Personal development and the acquisition of non-cognitive skills is an important part of education at Isendoorn College and therefore also of all international activities. The ten Isendoorn Competences are central to this.



Sustainable Development Goals

Thematically, the emphasis is on the major challenges we face as a school and as a society. This includes important issues in the areas of climate change, biodiversity, inequality and peace, security and justice. As a UNESCO school, we are in line with the sustainable development goals as drawn up by the United Nations. During their school career, students develop into global citizens. They not only acquire the knowledge and skills they need to operate in an international context. Above all, it becomes natural to look outward at the great challenges of the 21st century.

Isendoorn standard internationalization

To guarantee quality and uniformity within the internationalization programme, a checklist has been drawn up, with attention to what needs to be done in the various phases of a project (preparation, during the project, completion). This standard applies to every activity at Isendoorn College with an international aim, both within (during lessons) and outside the school. The aim is to comply with every part of the checklist as much as possible and to make adjustments where necessary. The checklist applies to every year and every level within Isendoorn College, although the extent to which a certain condition can be met may differ depending on the year/level and the nature of a project.

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
